UNIFORM POLICY

All students will wear HillSide's uniform 100% of the time while at school, as required by our uniform policy. Uniform policy is set at School Board level. It is mandatory for all students to comply with the uniform policy because it is an enrolment prerequisite. The College will review uniform as required and practicable. Staff will implement the policy in all sectors of the College.

Rationale

Uniforms are particularly important to our school ethos for the following reasons:

- Uniforms create a culture of equality. There is less competition in terms of fashion, and less incentive for students to use clothing to “out perform” other students;
- Uniforms train students to work as part of a team, and to be obedient to its requirements. Workers, sporting people, and other community organisations often stipulate strict dress codes for those who are part of the organisation;
- Uniforms support the ideal that students are part of the “bigger picture”. Students wearing uniforms realise their role in a community, which goes beyond the individual and focuses on the community aspect;
- Uniforms are part of the general tradition in Australia's education system, particularly in private school education;
- Uniforms identify a student as part of HillSide Christian College. This ensures accountability when wearing the uniform, both at school and in public;
- Uniforms create respect for boundaries and students understand this better;
- Uniforms worn neatly create and maintain a sense of school pride;
- HillSide is a private school and is, therefore, able to make site specific rules. Uniform is overwhelmingly supported by the Board, parent and staff body.

All uniform items must be clean, in good condition, fit appropriately and be worn in the manner for which they were designed.

If you are still in school uniform after school hours all dress standards apply and the complete uniform is to be worn in a positive representative way.

Uniform items that are available in the uniform shop are of College standard and must be bought from the College (NO substitutions). If for any reason, an item is unavailable, a note from the uniform shop will be given to the student and must be placed in their College diary (secondary) or given to the teacher (primary).

Appropriate uniform and personal presentation standards will be decided upon by the Principal and Deputy Principal. Any changes will be notified via the school newsletter.

ACCESSORIES

Boys

Hair - short, well groomed hair with no added colour. Hair is not to be beyond collar length and out of the eyes. Dramatic layered haircuts or long hair strands or any unusual “gelling” or teasing of hair is not permitted. Neat, tidy conservative styles only.

Jewellery - watches and chain with cross permissible. No rings, bangles or bracelets are acceptable. No earrings permissible (including clear studs).



Girls

Hair - clean and tidy with no added colour. Hair is to be off the collar and tied back from face. Dramatic layered haircuts or long hair strands or any unusual “gelling” or teasing of hair is not permitted. Neat, tidy conservative styles only.

Hair Accessories - are to be navy blue

Nails & Make Up - nails must be short and clean. No coloured nail polish.

Makeup (including, but not limited to, blush, eyeliner, eye shadow, foundation, lipstick and mascara) is not permitted.

Jewellery - one pair of earrings – plain studs or sleepers. Sleepers are to be no more than 1cm in diameter. Watches and chain with cross permissible. No rings, bangles or bracelets are acceptable.

School Backpacks

In 2018 the College Back Pack will be compulsory for all students from PP to Year 11.

Shoes & Socks

Shoes are to be black lace up school shoes with a small heel. Years 1 and 2 can wear the black leather velcro versions.



Sports shoes and the shoe laces are to be predominately black or white.

Socks - all socks are to be brought from the uniform shop to keep the standards of our presentation throughout the school.

Girls navy tights are available in the uniform shop for winter.

General Modesty

As a Christian College we believe that standard of modesty should be observed. Skirt/Shorts length needs to be conservative. This includes free dress day/discos etc.

Skirt/Dress Length

With your arms by your side, the length of your skirt/dress is to be no shorter than 15cm past fingertips.

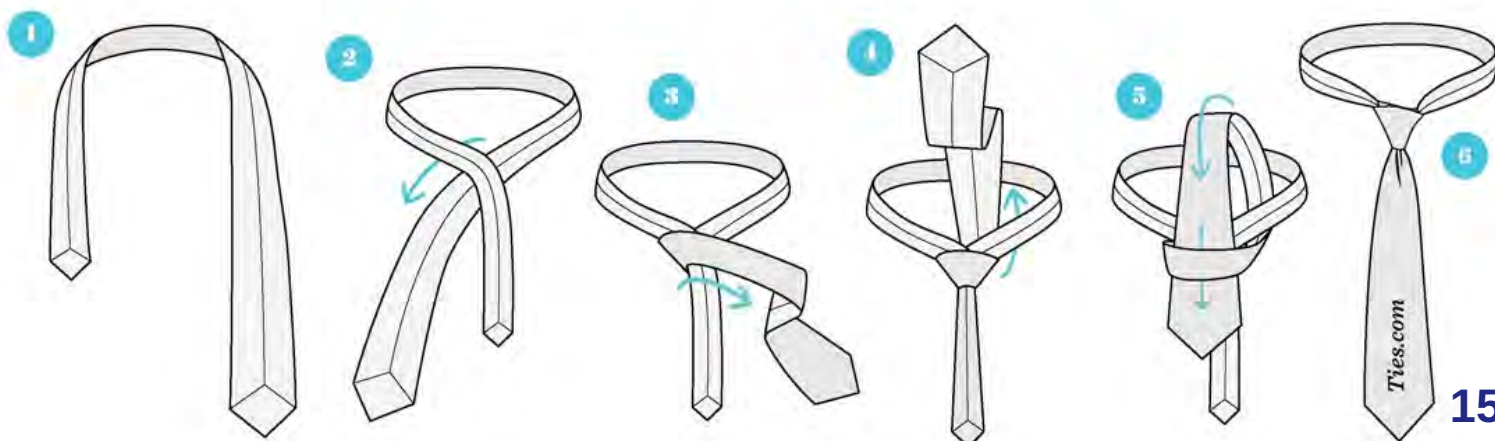

Grey up-down socks

1. Start with the reverse of the tie facing away from you, the wide end is on the right and the small end is on the left. The tip of the small end should rest slightly above the belly-button (this will vary depending on height and the length & thickness of your tie). Move only the active (wide) end.
2. Wide end under the small end to the left.
3. Across the small end to the right.
4. Up into the neck loop from underneath.
5. Down through the loop which has just made in the front.
6. Pull down on the wide end to tighten. Slide the knot up to adjust.



SHOE POLICY EXAMPLES

Correct Uniform	Incorrect Uniform	Comment
		Black leather lace-up shoes only. The incorrect shoe is a sports shoe, not a school shoe. Velcro is unacceptable for students in Years 3-12. Heels should be low, not over two centimetres high.
		Black leather lace-up shoes only. The incorrect shoe has no heel and a raised rubber front, which is not delineated from the shoe itself.
		Black leather lace-up shoes only. The incorrect shoe is a slip-on style, which is not permitted.
		Black leather lace-up shoes only. The incorrect shoe is a canvas, "volley" or "sneaker" style.
		Sports days only
		Sport shoes - predominately white or black sports shoe. The overall shoe should appear white or black. Laces to match shoe colour.
