
HIGH SCHOOL SEQTA GUIDE


Welcome Page

Access the latest newsletter and important updates directly from the SEQTA welcome page.




Absences

Easily notify the College if your child will be absent from school.




Assessments

View your child's assessment results and feedback to stay informed on their progress.




Courses

Explore each class lesson and access resources. Students can use this section to catch up on missed work if absent.




Courses

Any resources related to a lesson will be attached at the bottom of the page for easy reference.




Dashboard

Check the homework assigned to your child. If your child has an Individual Education Plan (IEP), their homework may be modified and therefore may not be displayed here.




Documents
